Product Information

LynCar Vinyl Shower Pan Liner

Meets or exceeds the specifications of ASTM D-4451-86b, which specifically covers vinyl shower pan liners. Is manufactured from 100% Virgin Poly Vinyl Chloride Resin. No regrind (regrind is recycled or ground up vinyl product which can be contaminated with foreign particles) is allowed in our liner. ASTM-D4451-86b requires that no regrind material be used in the manufacturing of this product.

Treated with biocides, which prevent the growth of mold, mildew or fungus. Vinyl products not similarly treated can fail due to micro-organism deterioration. Is unaffected by concrete or cement. The product maintains its integrity when installed in a damp, moist environment (typical of shower pans) away from sunlight and ozone. Under no circumstances should LynCar Vinyl Shower Pan Liner be used where there is direct exposure to the elements.

Markings

LynCar Vinyl Shower Pan Liner is clearly marked with LynCar's company name, and width. The product is also ruled every 6 inches for ease of measurement.

Typical Applications

Shower pans, gang shower pans, steam rooms, fountains, ornamental or reflecting pools. Any application of a full mortar bed (defined as any area requiring a minimum of 1" of mortar) and ceramic tile which requires a waterproof underlayment.

Installation

LynCar Vinyl Shower Pan Liner is relatively easy to install. No special training or tools are required. However, the installer must be familiar with the step-by-step instructions contained in this brochure. Installation of LynCar Vinyl Shower Pan Liner must be made in accordance with local plumbing codes.
